ACUTE - QUICK CLINIC

Quick Clinic is available between 2pm and 6pm Monday – Friday and 9 am – 12pm Saturdays.

We have 4 appointments for Respiratory Clinic from 11am -12pm to take the load off the afternoon.

If you suspect that you could have COVID 19, respiratory or flu symptoms or possibly infectious, please remain in your car and call 021 0896 4606. Do not come into clinic unless directed by doctors or nurses.

Please wear surgical mask, if directed by our staff.

We apologise there could be long wait times during Quick Clinic – thank you for your patience.

You will see the nurse for an initial assessment. Depending on the priority of your assessment you may be asked to book an appointment for another day to see your usual GP.

To reduce wait times, guidelines for Quick Clinic are as follows:

- ACUTE, QUICK appointments only.
- ONE issue only. If you have more than one issue, you may be advised to make an appointment on another day.
- NO WINZ or ACC medical certificates.
 NO routine medical check-ups.
 Appointments are required for these.
- Your accident/illness will be triaged by a nurse first.
- Urgency takes priority therefore; you may not necessarily be seen in the order you came in.
- If your request is NOT URGENT or QUICK, you may be advised by the nurse to make an appointment for another day.
- We will endeavor to keep you updated on wait times however, if you feel you have been waiting too long, please see

REPEAT PRESCRIPTIONS

You can order your repeat prescriptions with the nurse either by telephone or email:

Nurses answerphone – messages are checked twice daily at 11.30 am and 4 pm.

We will not phone back to confirm prescription orders on the answerphone.

In order to maintain the effectiveness of this process the following details are required:

Your name, folder number and/or date of birth The names and quantities of the medications you require.

Please allow a minimum of 24hrs when ordering your repeat prescription.

Same day prescriptions incur a \$5.00 surcharge

If you have not seen your GP for six months or more and, depending on your type of medication, your GP may request for you to make an appointment

Nurses phone service - nurses are able to give you your blood test results after the Dr. has reviewed them (usually 48 hours) You may be required to book an appointment with the Dr if you require further discussion.

Bloom Hearing is now opened next door at 81 Lincoln for your Audiology requirements. Please use the Kiosk in reception to register

ENROLMENTS

If you have not visited the doctor within 3 years, you are required to update your enrolment (by signing an enrolment form) to remain enrolled and receive subsidised fees. Casual fees apply if the enrolment has not been updated.

When enrolling, you will be required to show proof for eligibility by presenting a copy of photo ID documentation i.e. passport, or birth certificate with driver's licence.

Patients must be residing in New Zealand for 6 months (183 days) per year to remain enrolled.

If you move overseas, please see reception and arrange to collect your notes or, ask your new medical centre to arrange the medical notes to be transferred to them directly.

Please advise our receptionist of any change of contact details or other information.

FREE annual diabetes checks for patients with Type 1 and Type 2 diabetes. Please ensure you have your blood tests at least 2 days prior to your appointment.

Remember to bring in your care sense meter to review. Diabetes clinics are every Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday.

Spirometry (lung function testing)
